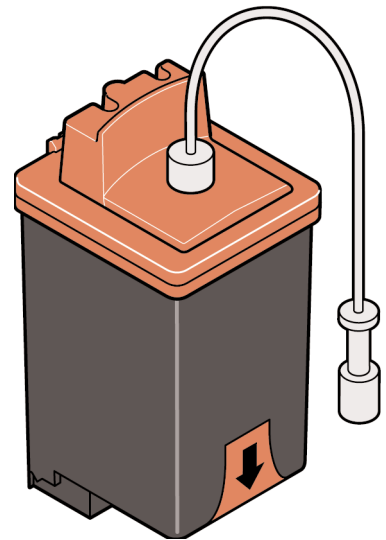
New Ink Cartridge Assembly

This is achieved through a new ink filling process together with increased ink volume in the cartridge. To improve shipping reliability and shelf life, the cartridges are vacuum-packed in an aluminum foil bag.
