Installation Instructions for Windows 2000 Professional:

Note: To install under Windows 2000 you must have Administrator privileges on the system.

- * Uninstall any previously installed versions of Easy Print
- * Open the CD in Windows Explorer
- * Double-click on 'EasySetup.bat'.
- * If the Java runtime environment is not already present, it will begin installing first. Accept default choices.
- * When the Java runtime install is done, Easy Print will install.
- * Click 'Next' on logo screen.
- * Select installation directory and click 'Next'.
- * Click on 'Accept' to accept the license agreement.
- * Click on 'Install' on release notes screen.
- * When extracting-files is done, Click on 'Next'.
- * Select desired default image source and click on 'Next'.
- * Select and name desired printer and click on 'Next'.
- * Select desired default media, ink type, and click 'Next'.
- * Reading the online user guide (UserGuide.pdf in the Doc folder) requires Acrobat Reader software. Acrobat Reader may be installed by double-clicking on the AcrobatReader5Setup.exe file in the Doc folder.

The UserGuide.PDF, ReleaseNotes.txt and ReadMe.txt files will be located in the /Doc sub-directory of the Easy Print installation directory on your PC.

Example: C:/EasyPrint/Doc/ReadMe.txt

1200 DPI support

This version of EasyPrint 5000 Software does not include support for 1200 DPI print modes.

Media Update via web server

There is a feature in the Easy Config application to allow new medias to be downloaded over the internet. This feature will not work correctly for systems behind a firewall proxy

that require password authentication for transfers. The workaround for this is to use a web browser to download the appropriate zip file using the following path:

ftp://ftp.Kodak.COM/EasyPrint/EasyPrintPC/MediaFilesPC.zip

Save the zip file to the local disk, and unzip it using a utility such as WinZip or Alladin Expander. Then, when performing the update change the path in the Add Media window to be the full path to where the files were unzipped. For example, if the files were unzipped into 'c:\temp' then enter 'c:\temp\EasyPrintPC' in the Add Media window.
